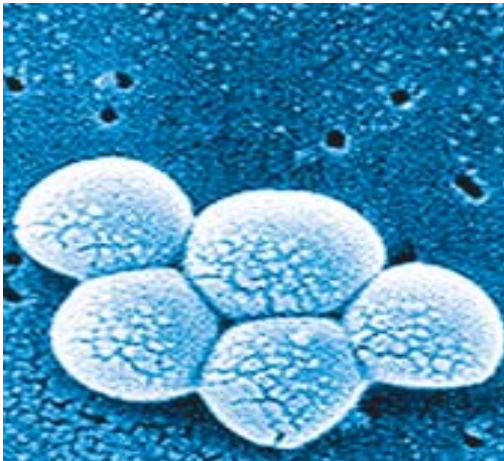


MRSA & MMR Problems



MRSA

(Methicillin-Resistant Staphylococcus Aureus)

- MRSA is a bacterium, which is resistant to the more widely used antibiotics.
- It is found on the skin or in the nose of up to 40% of people without causing harm.
- However, in some people who have broken skin, (such as patients who have had an operation), it can cause boils and wound infection.



MMR Vaccine



- Vaccine for Measles, Mumps and Rubella.
